Last year for Christmas Nina got a replica of the "Come and Take It Cannon" which she has proudly shown to customers, foreign visitors, and 4th grade students on school tours. This year she added a rare document signed by both Sam Houston and Gail Borden and Texas Declaration of Independence signers Jesse Grimes and William Fisher dated 1835. She loves sharing the signatures of these Texas Greats with our customers.

Great finds come in small packages sometimes. Nina's friends at the "Antiquarium" introduced her to a very rare antique Christmas postcard which now hangs with our collection.

This exceptional piece is by artist and political cartoonist Thomas Nast who gave us the 'Santa' of the original "Twas the Night Before Christmas" and our nation's Uncle Sam. This postcard, dated 1907-1909 was pre-WWI, printed in Germany and depicts Uncle Sam as "Santa" with a bag of toys. It is postmarked December 25, 1909 and simply signed Momma.
